With the proceeds from the Pig Pickin' in the Park, the Cary-Kildaire Rotary Club has awarded over \$520,000 in scholarships since 1986. The James Atkins Memorial Scholarship has supported 59 students at fouryear colleges and universities and 45 students that completed programs at Wake Tech Community College. 25 residents of the Boys and Girls Home of North Carolina have been able to attend college and trade schools through the Bill Phelps Memorial Scholarship. James Atkins was a charter member of the Cary-Kildaire Rotary Club. Most notable was James' leadership while serving on the Wake County Board of Education during the late 70's. His community and church activities were numerous an varied, allowing him to touch the lives of many, which is what the Cary-Kildaire Rotary Club has tried to emulate with the annual Pig Pickin in the Park

James' creed was: "Never take more out of a community than you are willing to put in."

Humanitarian Projects

Internationally, the Cary-Kildaire Rotary Club supports many critical humanitarian initiatives. Some of these initiatives include: the global fight against polio, providing clean drinking water/sanitation to schools in India and Lebanon, purchasing equipment for schools/hospitals, an ultrasound scanner and dialysis units for a kidney hospital in India, a braille printer for a school for the blind in Nepal, and an audiometer for a school for hearing and visually impaired children in India.

Domestically, the Cary-Kildaire Rotary Club currently supports the NC Boys and Girls Home in Lake Waccamaw, The Dementia Alliance of North Carolina, Note in the Pocket, The Food Bank of NC, Miracle League and several other worthy local non-profit organizations working to help those in need.
